### SCHOOL FEES

A deposit of **CHF 5'000 for a boarder / CHF 2'000 for a day student** which is not included in the school fees, is required to cover other expenses such as private lessons, clothing purchases and birthdays. The balance will be updated at the end of the school year.

Pocket money must also be provided by the parents (between CHF 10 and CHF 40 per week depending on the age of the child) and handed in to the office for safe keeping.

### FEES INCLUDE:

Full room and board, tuition, health and accident insurance\*, ski pass, supervised studies, use of the school text books and supplies, laundry, use of the network, the sports activities, the cultural activities, transport to and from Geneva airport (*only within the official dates and times*), various taxes and VAT.

\*10% will be charged to the parents as by Swiss law.

### FEES DO NOT INCLUDE:

Cultural trips, some expeditions, the private lessons, the rent of the ski equipment, the rent of the ski uniform (jacket and pants), the official exams (ex: Cambridge, ...), the pocket money, the birthdays, and any extra expenses (ex: hairdresser, dentist, ...).

For the day students, the ski pass, day trips, expedition and the health insurance *are not included*.

### CLUB FEES

The clubs for Japanese, German, Russian, Chinese, Karate, Chess, Ballet, Dance, French, English and ice skating are CHF 490 per term.



# School Regulations

## FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

For each new boarder, a single non-refundable payment of CHF 2'000 is required. This amount covers the enrolment costs and is non-reimbursable in the event of cancellation. If parents cancel their child's admission 60 days or less before the beginning of a term, the school will not refund the sum paid. Any term begun is to be paid in full. This is also valid in the event of a voluntary departure, late arrival, prolonged absence or dismissal.

If there are several boarders from the same family (brothers and sisters) enrolled at the school, the following reduction of fees will be made to the school fees only: 10% for the second child, 15% for the third child, 20% for the fourth and any additional children. The school reserves the right to dismiss, at any time, a student who has proven to be an unsatisfactory member of the school community. There will be no refunding. We would like to inform you the financial conditions might change every year. The school rules may change during the school year.

In case of litigation between the school and the parents, Swiss Legislation is the only law applicable in all matters concerning this contract. The competent tribunal will be that of the district of Aigle.

## PORTABLE COMPUTERS, MOBILE PHONES & PHONE CALLS

Computers (Mac or PC) are obligatory and the must meet the La Garenne requirements (please see the rules and regulations for computer use). Students are allowed to bring their mobile phones to school. Mobile telephones must be given to the school office and may only be used with the consent of the management. The students have monitored access to their computer and the Internet. Phone calls are allowed on Wednesday evenings from 7:15 to 8:15 pm and Sunday morning from 10:30 to 11:30am.

## PRIVATE LESSONS

Children have a wide choice of the following options: French, English, Chinese, Japanese, karate, Italian, Russian, piano, violin, guitar, art, and tennis. All options chosen must be followed throughout the duration of the school year and by approved by the Head Teacher. In order to not overburden the students, it's recommended that parents choose **a maximum of two options.**

## EXAMS & SCHOOL SHOW

At the end of each term the students have exams. Any exams missed cannot be retaken and they will be replaced with the minimum score. No departure is authorised before the official end of term dates. The end of year show involves the participation of every student. The presence of the parents would be greatly appreciated.

## WEEKENDS & VISITS

The parents must notify the direction no later than the **Wednesday** evening before the weekend of each departure. Students can be collected at 16h30 on the Friday and brought back to the main building on Sunday between 17h30 and 18h00. If a student is in red, they are to remain at La Garenne for the weekend. All new students must remain at La Garenne for the first two weeks. All visits to the school must be confirmed at least 48 hours in advance. Each student must have the authorisation from their parent(s) or legal guardian before leaving the school with another person.

## POCKET MONEY

According to the child's age, parents should provide a reasonable amount of pocket money (between CHF 10 and CHF 40 per week). The school declines all responsibility for the loss of valuable objects or money if these have not been deposited with the office. All the Junior students go shopping in small unsupervised groups.

## VISAS

If the students require a visa to enter a country not included in the Schengen zone, the school requires that the parents undertake all the necessary procedures.

## RE-ENROLMENT

Parents wishing to withdraw their child for the next school year, must inform the Director in writing **before March 30<sup>th</sup>**. La Garenne International School keeps a place for every student whose registration has not been cancelled.

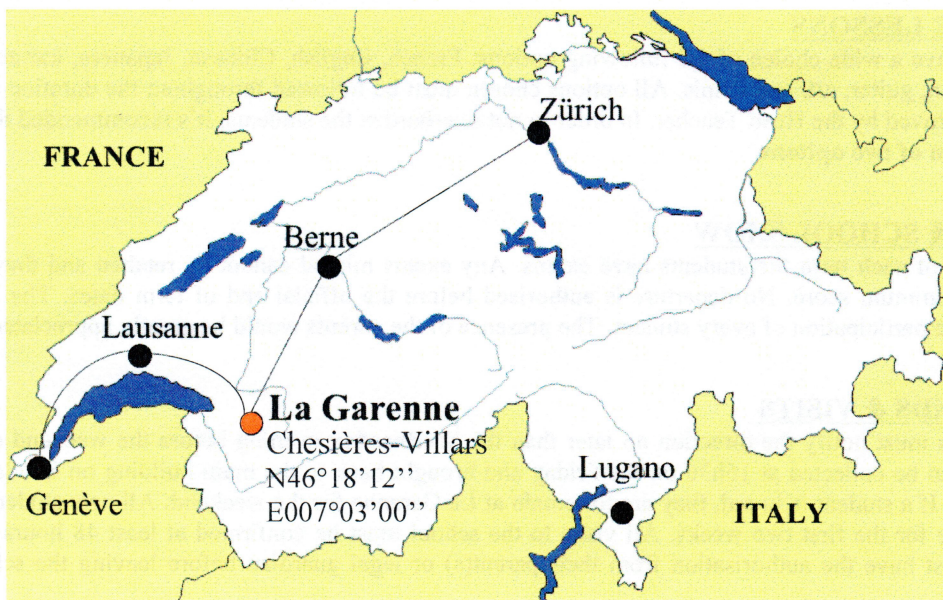
