



## American High School Subjects and Course Details

### **High School Program (College preparatory) 9th Grade**

- Freshman English
- Basic Mathematics
- Pre-algebra
- Algebra - 101
- General Science (all three sciences will be taught separately at Surval)
- Global Studies
- French – 101 (or another foreign language)

### **High School Program (College preparatory) 10th Grade**

- Sophomore English
- Algebra (Maths is taught as a complete subject, but for those taking the High School Program there is an emphasis on discrete aspects such as geometry, trigonometry etc)
- Geometry
- Biology
- World History
- World Geography
- French – 202 (or another foreign language)

### **High School Program (College preparatory) 11th Grade**

- American Literature and Composition
- Advanced Algebra
- Trigonometry and Pre-Calculus
- Chemistry
- United States History
- French – 303 (or another foreign language)

### **High School Program (College preparatory) 12th Grade**

Students are only accepted to the 12th grade at the beginning of the academic year in the fall trimester. They must have credits in the core subjects: English, French (or another foreign language), Social Studies, Mathematics and Science.

- World Literature
- Math Analysis
- Physics
- European History



- Global problems - world issues
- Advanced French (or equivalent advanced foreign language course)

All courses in the High School program can be combined where the timetable allows with IGCSE and A level options, as well as the Surval Culinary Arts (cooking and pastry) and etiquette (culture and customs) courses. Every girl will be involved in the enrichment programme of activities, sporting, charitable, musical, and academic.
